



Frank Valentine Volunteer Award

The Award is named for Frank Valentine, who was a tireless advocate for seniors' issues in the Kanata region for many years. He was the instigator behind the formation of the Kanata Seniors Council in 1996.

**The award is to be given to a volunteer who:
Is an adult, or couple, 55 years or older, who has provided outstanding leadership to this community, focusing on senior needs: who has consistently improved the quality of life of seniors in our community over a wide range of activities. For a contribution of ongoing strong and consistent volunteering, over an extended period of time, to ensure the empowerment of services and continuing enjoyment of the seniors, that are provided in this Senior Centre.**

How to Nominate someone for the Frank Valentine Volunteer Award:

- 1) Complete the nomination form. Available by June 19 on the Council website (council@kanataseniors.ca) or at the Front Desk of the Kanata Seniors' Centre,**
- 2) Write a short summary of the volunteer's contributions,**
- 3) The nominator should provide sufficient information to give the selection committee a good idea of the impact of the volunteer's service,**
- 4) Submit the nomination form and summary by Friday August 11, 2017 to The Kanata Seniors Council at the Front Desk of the Seniors' Centre.**

The Award will be presented at the Kanata Seniors Council Annual General Meeting on Monday, September 11, 2017 at the Kanata Seniors' Centre, Mlacak Halls, 2500 Campeau Drive, Kanata.
