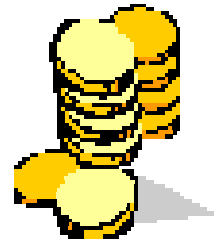

All area Shoppers offers a Senior's Day the last Thursday of every month. Seniors get 20 % with an Optimum Card (which can be obtained free at the store) and 15 % without that card. Discounts excludes: sale items, prescriptions, insulin, codeine, tobacco products, newspapers, stamps, Life Experiences, lottery and bus tickets, electronic gift cards and prepaid phone cards. Discounts may not exceed \$50. Shoppers also have Super Senior's Day every few months. Information on those days will be listed in that week's flyer.

Seniors save 20% every last Tuesday of the month! (Applies to regular prices; excluding sale items, prescriptions, products with codeine, Home Health Care products, Gift Cards, lottery, transit tickets, baby formula and diapers, prepaid phone cards, cigarettes, fresh milk & bread and photofinishing.)
